Day 1 - Wednesday, July 1, 2009

Arrive Whitehorse, Yukon

Today we will depart from our home cities and arrive in **Whitehorse**, in the Yukon to begin an amazing adventure as we explore the lands of the midnight sun. Tonight we will arrive at our hotel in the heart of **Whitehorse** - perhaps we might explore our surroundings, or just relax after the journey.

Day 2 - Thursday, July 2, 2009

Whitehorse

For many people the name **Whitehorse** conjures up visions of the **Klondike Gold Rush**, sled dogs and the brave pioneers who fought the elements to build the **Alaska Highway**, but this morning we will tour a beautiful, modern city, as we enjoy **Miles Canyon**, the **Fish Ladder**, the **Beringia Centre** and the **Transportation Museum**. This afternoon a tour of the **S.S. Klondike** - a **National Historic Site** which commemorates the role these stern-wheelers played in the history of the Yukon. Tonight, a special evening at the **Whitehorse Frantic Follies** - considered by many to be the best entertainment in the Yukon.

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Day 3 - Friday, July 3, 2009

Whitehorse - Dawson City

Now we will depart **Whitehorse** and travel north to another exciting city in the Yukon - **Dawson City**. On our way we will stop for a delicious **cinnamon bun**, and to view the lovely **Five Finger Rapids**. We will arrive in **Dawson City** in time to explore this unique city in the midnight sun.

Hotel: **The Downtown Hotel** - 3 nights

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Day 4 - Saturday, July 4, 2009

Dawson City

A full day is planned in this city, a **National Historic Site**, as we visit an actual **Gold Mining Dredge** and try **Panning for Gold**. There are so many unique sights to see. Perhaps we can tour the historic **Commissioner's Residence** or enjoy a recital of a **Robert Service** poem at his cabin. Tonight we will visit the famous **Diamond Tooth Gertie's Casino**, the oldest casino Canada.

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Day 5 - Sunday, July 5, 2009

Dawson City

This morning we will drive a section of the famous '**Dempster Highway**'. The highway connects the **Klondike Highway** in the Yukon to **Inuvik**, on the **Mackenzie River**. This is one of the most beautiful and awe inspiring roads in the world. We will cross mountain ranges, traverse valleys and view nature at it's finest. We will also enjoy a picnic lunch along the way.

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Day 6 - Monday, July 6, 2009

Dawson City - Tok

Today we will cross the international border, into **Alaska**. The surrounding scenery is spectacular as we travel the '**Top of the World**' highway on our way to **Tok**. We will lunch at **Chicken** and continue on to **Tok**, the '**sled dog capital**' of the world. This evening is free to enjoy at our leisure.

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Day 7 - Tuesday, July 7, 2009

Tok - Fairbanks

This morning we will continue on to **Fairbanks**. On the way we will spend some time at '**Santa Clause House**', **North Pole, Alaska**. Today we will also get our first glimpse of the **Alaska Pipe Line**, and enjoy our lunchtime break at **Rika's Roadhouse**, located in the **Big Delta Historical Park** - truly a charming setting. This evening we will attend the **Golden Heart Review** at the **Palace Theatre**.

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Day 8 - Wednesday, July 8, 2009

Fairbanks

An exciting day is planned as we board the **Riverboat Discovery III** for a three and a half hour cruise on the **Cheena** and **Tenana** rivers, and experience a traditional **Athabaskan** fish camp, and also see an **Alaskan bush pilot** in action. This evening a special '**treat**' is in store. We will dine at a traditional **Salmon Bake**, a delicious Alaskan custom, after which we can enjoy time at **Pioneer Park**, which is adjacent to our hotel.

Hotel: **Comfort Inn** - 1 night

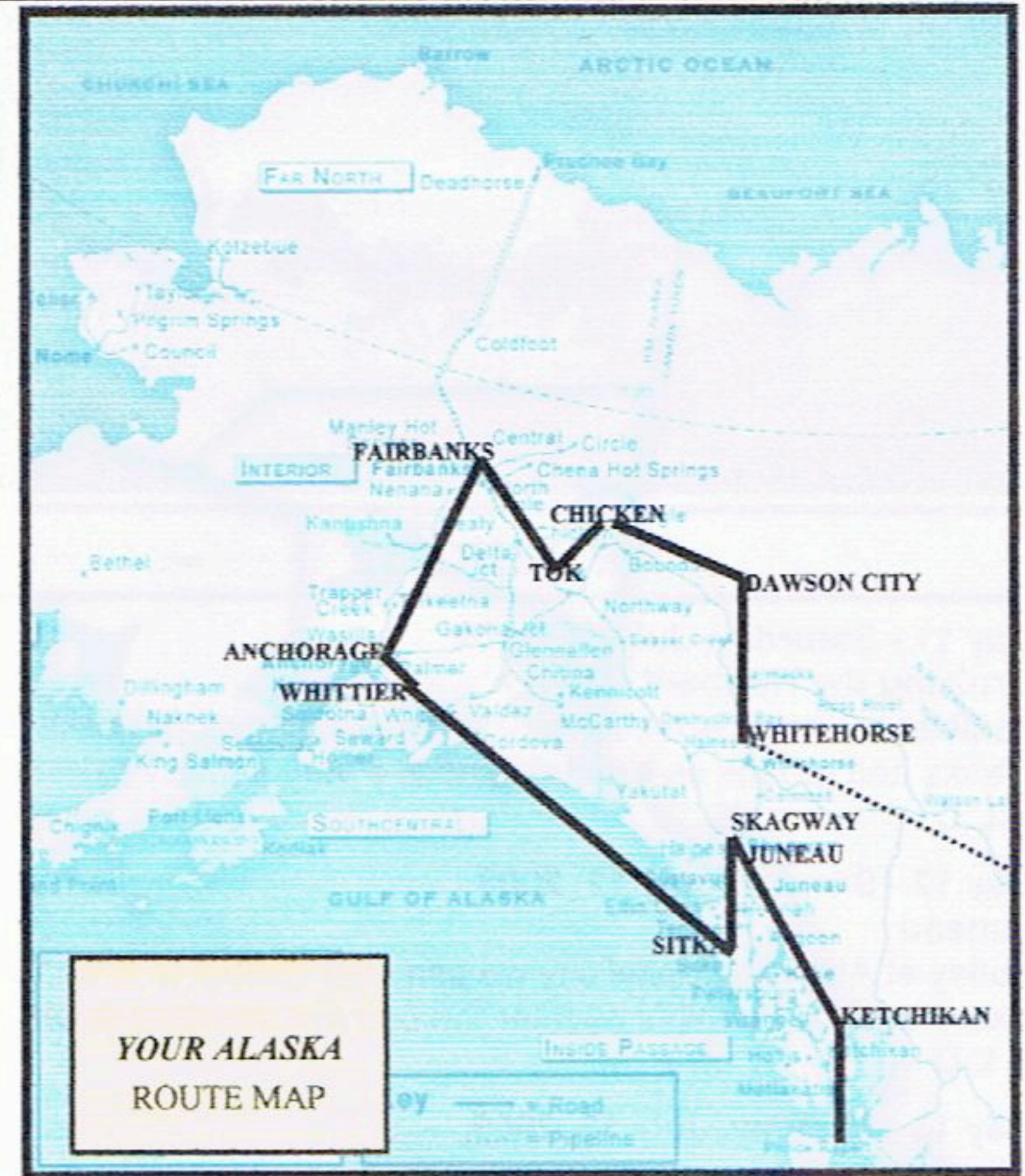
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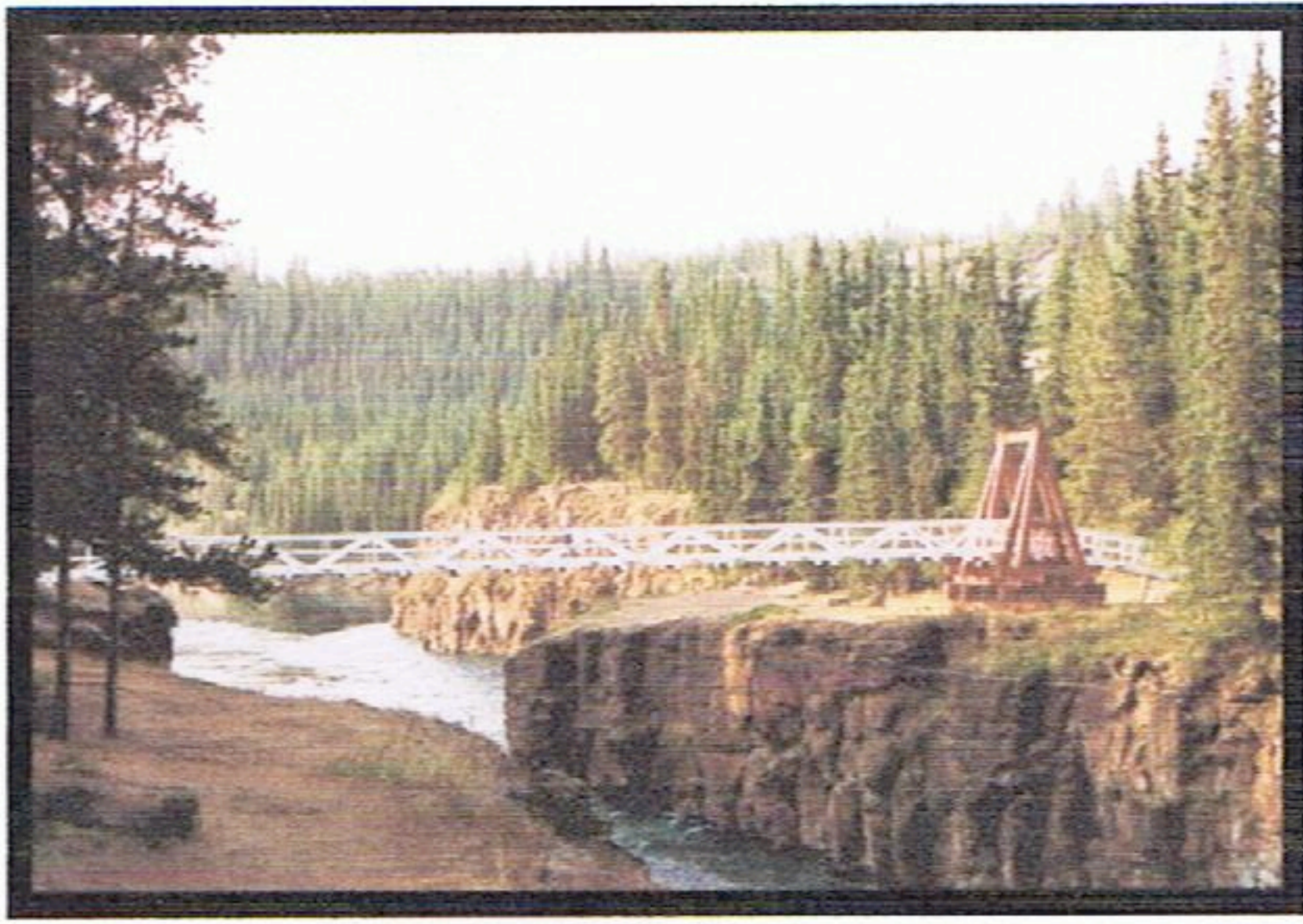
Day 10 - Friday, July 10, 2009

Embark the Royal Caribbean 'Radiance Of The Seas'

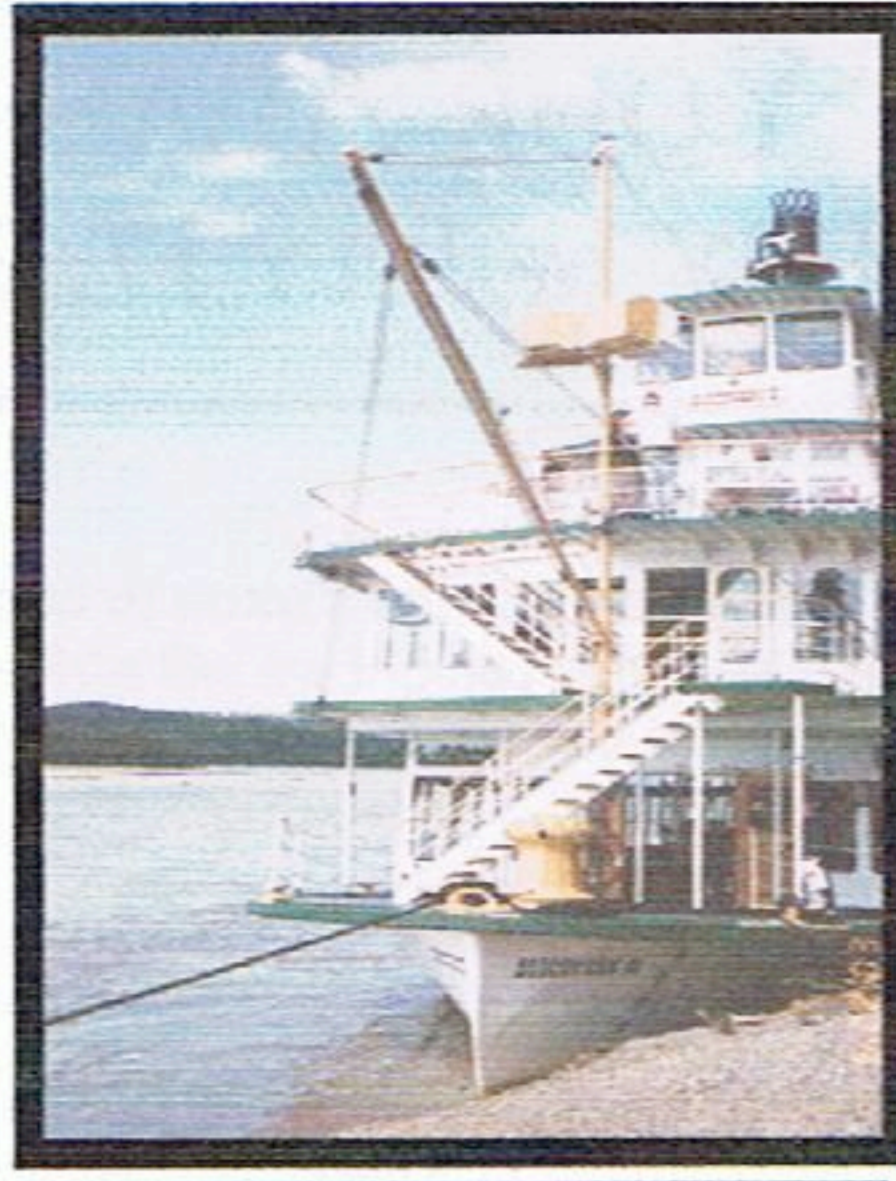

Day 13 - Monday, July 13, 2009

Skagway

Against all odds, an iron trail was born of the 1898 Klondike Gold Rush and built through some of the North's most ruggedly beautiful terrain, and today we may choose to ride in the refurbished train cars of the White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad, and follow the original route through the famous Dead Horse Gulch. We will have some free time to explore the unique town of Skagway before the ship sails.

Day 14 - Tuesday, July 14, 2009

Icy Strait Point

Icy Strait Point is located near the city of Hoonah, the largest native Tlingit Indian settlement in Alaska, and very near Glacier Bay National Park. Home to a historic cannery, the port's connection to the sea is strong. Locals share the sea with humpback whales, orcas, Dall porpoises, seals, sea otters, halibut and all five species of Pacific salmon. It is not uncommon to spot a humpback or an orca while walking along the shore.

Day 15 - Wednesday, July 15, 2009

Ketchikan

With the 3,000-foot-high Deer Mountain looming behind, Ketchikan could not expand. Therefore, much of the town is built on trestles, docks and pilings at water's edge. Explore historic Creek Street, now a quaint area of galleries and boutiques, or indulge in the majesty of a flight-see of Misty Fjords - another spectacular option.
