





This beautiful and historic resort city can compete with the Rivira with its sunny beaches and high-end shopping. After another day of cruising, stop at Huatulco for a day of mezcal tasting and shopping.

Days 7-9 | After leaving Mexico, you'll head to San Juan del Sur, Nicaragua a couple of days away. Spend a romantic day touring the cobblestoned streets of this historic colonial city at the base of a volcano. The following day, rafting down the Corobici River looking out for iguanas, monkeys, and otters.

Days 10-13 | Expect daily excursions through Panama, Costa Rica, and Columbia as you make your way through the canal. Learn about the area's rich history in the gold industry in Panama city and canoe through the mangrove tunnels in Cartagena.

Days 9-11 | The island of Moorea is known for its stunning natural beauty. Plan to spend the day hiking through the mountains or taking a guided tour with a professional photographer who will bring your vacation photos to a new level.





Day 5 | Skagway is known for its charming goldrush era architecture. The town acts as a gateway to the Yukon. There are plenty of family-friendly attractions to be found around town like the historical reenactments and the beautiful train ride through the Yukon.

Day 6 | As the state capital, Juneau is the largest metropolitan area in the state. The city offers flights over the glaciers, dog sledding adventures, and the Glacier Gardens.

Days 7-9 | The final Alaskan stop is in Ketchikan to watch carvers creating totem poles at the Saxman Native Village or hike through the Alaska Rainforest Sanctuary. The last few days are spent on the water headed for Vancouver. Plan to spend a day taking advantage of the cultural touchpoints of a major city like the Aquarium, Gastown Park, and Chinatown.





The Mekong flows across 3,000 miles in Asia. Make this birthday memorable by touring through Cambodia and Vietnam. Spend one day touring ancient temples and meditating with Bhuddist monks and the next shopping the open air markets of Phnom Penh and Ho Chi Minh.



Day 5-6 | Meet the locals of Cambodia.

Take an ox cart ride through the country and have lunch at a small farm. Partake in water blessing at Angkor Ban and visit the silversmith to see how he works his craft the same way his ancestors have for centuries.

Day 7 | Tour through Phnom Penh on a private cyclo. Visit the Royal Palace, National Museum, and Silver Pagoda.

Day 8-10 | Stops in Vietnam include a demonstration in conical hat making, rice wine tastings, and cooking classes led by local chefs using traditional recipes and local ingredients.

Day 11-12 | This multi-day stop in Ho Chi Minh gives you the chance to have a drink at the famous Rex Hotel or take part in the Cu Chi Tunnels excursion. There is plenty of sightseeing to be done in this beautiful and modern cultural center.



Day 1-2 | Spend your first days of vacation cruising Amsterdam's famous canals or taking a bike tour through the quaint cobblestoned streets.


Day 3 | Take a walk through Cologne Heights or hop on a bicycle for a guided tour of the city's Jewish heritage.
